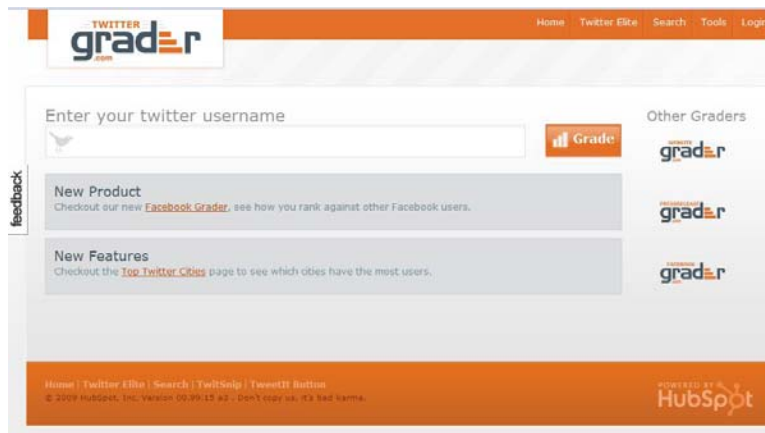
There are good, and bad ways to find people to follow on Twitter.

Services and methods that require you to read individual profiles and choose people you actually want to follow = good.

There are sites that will recommend good people for you to follow.

<http://www.grader.com> – this provides you with your “grade” and also provides lists of top users by state, subject, and overall. You can see information about these people, and if you are signed in to Grader.Com you can follow right from there.



<http://mrtweet.net/> - This is Mr. Tweet your personal Twitter Networking assistant. He'll help you find good people.



Mr. Tweet is your personal networking agent who helps you expand your network easily. To do that, he helps you regularly:

1. Get relevant followers by recommending you to them
2. Discover great people relevant to your current needs
3. Improve your Twitter usage via useful statistics

On your main Twitter page, there is a link on the right that says EVERYONE. Click that, and just watch people tweet. If someone seems interesting, click on their avatar and check them out.

If you see someone you admire, or enjoy, look at that person's profile and see who THEY follow. Odds are you'll find likeminded folk to follow.
